Abuse on doctors have been well documented and needs no further proof. Abuse and violence on doctors have ceased to be of any news value and has become part of everyday scene. The day to stop this was yesterday. Soft spoken doesn't mean Soft target. Covid 19 pandemic, apart from the nature's fury shall be known for high handedness. The non science implementers of the Health Emergency deal it as if it is a law and order issue. Setting unachievable targets without adequate manpower and support staff, the districts are a rule unto themselves. Guidelines of Union Government are interpreted differently in each district of the country. It is unfortunate that the medical profession is in the crossfire. 





# PEPS IMA Activities – June 2020

As a part our endeavour to help and assist our members in the wake of lockdown and scarcity of infection control Equipments we supplied personnel protection Equipments and infection control kits to wherever needed. IMA PEPSMED ensures protection of medical fraternity by supplying all the medical equipments and items.

We are co-ordinating the supply of Bio Medical Waste collection Bags & Containers to all the Health Care Institutions and CFLTCs for collecting COVID Bio Medical waste all over Kerala. We are also doing consultation services for CFLTCs based on their enquiries. Almost 250 CFLTCs were temporarily affiliated till June 2020.

In Government sector we have supplied Equipments worth Rs 300977/- at ESI Alapuzha and Equipments worth Rs. 85200/- at Govt General Hospital, Adoor. Also we have submitted a Quote to ESI, Palakkad at Rs. 303660/- for supplying Ophthalmic Instruments. I Safe Network

I Safe Network Infection Control Training was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020 at 3 PM for those who have not attended the Zonal trainings. Large number of members were trained in this meeting.





On 15-06-2020 conducted zoom platform training on I Safe Infection Control Training at 3.00 PM. The training was inaugurated by Dr. Abraham Varghese, State President in the presence of Dr. P. Gopikumar, State Secretary, Dr. Sreejith N. Kumar, Chairman PEPS & Dr. Cyriac Thomas Secretary PEPS. Above 100 institutions attended the training and the sessions were headed by our senior leaders Dr. Jayakrishnan AV, Dr. Pradeep Kumar VG, Dr. Sreekumar RC etc.





The second phase of I Safe Network was established with the intention to enrol small (OP alone) and medium institutions (upto 20 beds) for continuing Infection control practice. 418 institutions joined in the Network. Training on infection control was carried out on Zonal basis with six districts in North, four in mid and four in south zones. Training was given to Doctors on zoom platform. Paramedical staffs were also encouraged to participate. 351 institutions underwent the training. Further a new set of infection control kit was send to these institutions free of cost. German consulate helped in sponsoring the kits. These kits comprised of 3 Layer Masks, Premium 3 Layer Masks, Gloves, Disinfectants, Sanitizers, Soap Solutions and Face Shield. They were also provided with a certificate and poster for display.

# IMAGE - COVID BIOMEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT – UPDATE – JUNE 2020

IMA Goes Eco-friendly or "IMAGE" has become a "synonym" for the Biomedical Waste Management for Kerala. During this Covid pandemic, IMAGE is the only agency managing the biomedical waste generated during the diagnosis, care & treatment of Covid Patients in Kerala.

This prestigious project of Indian Medical Association - IMAGE - commenced its operation in the year 2004 and its plant is situated in Kanjikode, Palakkad. IMAGE is presently the largest Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility in the Country and the only such facility for the entire state of Kerala. IMAGE is governed by a Managing Committee of 45 Committed Doctors from the Indian Medical Association, headed by the IMA State President, State Secretary & Chairman, Dr. V. U. Seethi.


As on June 30th, IMAGE is giving service to 15,876 institutions, including all Govt. Healthcare Centres across the Kerala. Of this, 153 Centres are affiliated to IMAGE for their Covid Biomedical Waste management.

Since 19<sup>th</sup> March 2020, IMAGE has managed 389 M. Tonnesof Covid Biomedical Waste. Including this Covid waste, total biomedical waste managed by IMAGE per day is average 48 Tonnes. The entire waste is transported on the same day & scientifically treated and disposed-off within the next 24 hours, in the IMAGE Plant.

The success of Covid biomedical waste management is depended on the proper segregation of waste at the source; and "IMAGE" is giving continuous training to all its affiliated institutions for this proper segregation, as per the colour codes described in the BMW Management Rules. Yellow Buckets & double-layered bags are used for collecting the Incinerable waste, Red buckets & double-layered bags for the Autoclavable waste, White or transparent containers for the Sharps & Blue Containers for the Metals & Glass.

The Covid Biomedical Waste Management is done separately from the regular biomedical waste by IMAGE; and both these are monitored separately through the IMAGE software (https://imaimage.biz)& tracking applications of both CPCB & IMAGE (COVID19BWMApp&IMA-IMAGEHCEApp).

IMAGE is using 60 GPS enabled Covered trucks; of this, 18 trucks are exclusively used for the collection & transportation of Covid Biomedical Waste. The vehicle management & tracking is done through a dedicated software (AVL view https://app.avlview.com).

The DMO Kannur has recommended to post 14 Modern MediiProfessionals working in private sector for duty in the Kannur Medical College CoVid hospital. This is without the knowledge of the concerned persons and the hospitals where they are presently working. This move from the district administration will jeopardize the functioning of these hospitals which manage the non CoVid patients who were lacking follow up for the past two months because of the pandemic and lock down. More so when these specialists single handedly manage their departments in those hospitals.

We believe that there is no such dire necessity to take such an action at present, without taking into confidence the professionals and the institutions in the private sector.

When private sector whole heartedly give their support and cooperation the Govt for managing the CoVid pandemic, these isolated move from district administrations cannot be viewed as an encouraging one. The concerned doctor's remuneration and job security in the current institution, once this pandemic subsides, should be ensured before making such move.

Respected sir,

Indian Medical Association stands with the government in the fight against Covid 19 management. We appreciate the action taken by the Govt in controlling the disease spread till date. The dedicated work of the health care workers, police personnel and the government servants deserve appreciation and the Govt coordinated the activities efficiently and we appreciate the Govt for seeking IMA's views and soliciting our support. Our expert committee analysed in detail the strategy so far in consultation with global experts and global scenario and has come out with the following suggestions.

The major areas to be focused are enumerated in the attached document. The lock down intended to arrest the massive spread was effective, but that time period was not effectively utilised for the preparedness for the next stages. The importance of infection prevention methods were not effectively driven into the common man's mind. This lead to the worsening of the situation, including community spread, as seen today. Studies on transmission, epidemiological studies are very important at this juncture, probably long overdue.

The infectivity amog doctors and other health care workers are on the increase, including those in the non covid healthcare facility. This indicates the necessity for widespread tests in the community, especially doctors and healthcare workers since they may be asymptomatic carriers. Request your favorable reply on this as a Doctor's Day gift.

Russin will start giving its first drug approved to trest COVID-19 to patients next week, its state financial backer said, a move it hopes will ease strains on the health system.

Russian hospitals can begin giving the antiviral drug, which is registered under the name Avilovir, to patients from June II, the head of Russia's RDIF sovereign wealth fund told Reuters in an interview. He said the company behind the drug would manufacture enough to treat around 60,000 peo-

ple a month. There is currently no vaccine for COVID-19, the disrocavirus, and human trials of several existing antivital drugs have yet to show

efficacy.

Avifavit, known generically as favipiravit, was first developed in the late 1990s by a farsinese company later bought by Fujifilm as it moved into bealthcare

RDIF head Kiril Dmirriev said Russian scientists had meditied the drug to enhance it, and said Moscow would be ready to share the details of those modifications within two weeks. Japan has been trialling the same drug, known there as Avigan. It has won plaudits from Prime Minister Shingo Abe and \$128 million in go





Include Branch President and Secretary in the committee. 2. Proper infection control (N95/FFP2, face shields and PPES) protocol should be adhered. 3. District level training should be initiated. 4. Proper Testing facilities should be implemented. 5. Posters and safe practice advisory should be distributed. 6. Privilege group members can join training sessions and they will be provided items with subsidised rates.







# **IMA-KSB Ethics Committee**

It is noted that incidences of violation of medical ethics are escalating at disconcerting rates in the state. The ethics committee has been frequently receiving complaints about doctors engaging in improper advertisements with photographs, and unrecognized qualifications..

These are gross violations of Section 6.1.1of the Code of Ethics of IMC Regulations, 2002, ("...a physician shall not make use of his/her name as subject of any form or manner of advertising or publicity through any mode either alone or in conjunction with others ... as to invite attention to him or to his professional position, skill, qualification ...") and 6.1.2 (Printing of self photograph, or any such material of publicityshall be regarded as acts of self advertisement and unethical conduct).

Furthermore, TCMC has stipulated that:

"Practitioner shall display as suffix to their names only recognized medical degrees, and any additional qualification not registered in TCMC should not be exhibited in letter pads and name boards". Violations of this code may lead to punitive action..

MCI's Code of Ethics is specifically binding on the doctors and not the hospitals. So even if it is the hospital which is advertising, the practitioner alone will be held liable for the violation of medical ethics. It is the duty of the doctors to ensure that their employer does not use their photographs and unrecognized degrees.

A medical practitioner is permitted only to make a formal announcement in presson starting practice, changing type & address of practice, and about temporary absence from duty.

In this context, the members are notified that the IMA State Ethics committee is bound to bring such violations as mentioned above, to the TCMC, which may result in dire consequences. Offences are being frequently penalized violations of medical ethics, so that the number of such incidences comes down in future.by IMC and TCMC, with punishments from censure to temporary suspension of registration.




